# Thanks so much for supporting the Shrevewood Elementary School Fun Run Fundraiser.

It was wonderful to see Shrevewood students determined to run all 35 laps to raise the maximum amount of money for their school. Seeing the smiles on their faces and watching them cheer their classmates on reminded me that this is not only a fundraiser but it's a fun time to be had by all.

We received \$23,000 in pledge promises. As of Wednesday, Nov 9, we have collected 91% of the pledge promises. Our goal is to collect 100% - we are well on our way!

The money from this fundraiser benefit the entire Shrevewood student body as it will be used for playground and outdoor enhancements.
