Admin Updates

- Mr. DeSmyter, Principal, Ms. Lilburn, Asst. Principal
- Josh thanked Kate for having Mary at the meeting; always learn something new with her
- Spending of Fall Fundraiser money planning to make an adjustment. In the fall, we talked about professional development in-house and flex seating in the classrooms. But, they were able to do a lot of professional development in-house without the additional funds because they got funding from FCPS and April Done was creative in how she implemented it. That left money on the table for other resources.
- Instead, they'd like to use the full fundraising money to start the flexible seating for the school. They want to order it now before the spring fundraiser. They'll share some options for the flexible seating and tables at the next meeting.
- Planning to start with the 6th grade and then work down in the grades so they have time to use the materials. For example, they're looking at dry erase tables with adjustable heights. They have some of these for pull-out special education cases. But they're hoping to get at least 3 tables per classroom for 6th and 5th grade.
- Will also leverage funds from the spring book fair and read a thon to help outfit the entire building before next school year. Hoping shipping doesn't take too long...

- Continuing to observe and work on differentiation in the classrooms.
- They've started working on a Sensory Room at the school for kids who don't communicate as well, don't know the language, have anxiety, etc. They have noticed that a lot of kids need a sensory space to help them get through the rest of the general education of the day. They're leveraging county resources for social/emotional funding to help build this room upstairs in the building for therapy, de-escalation, safe space, etc.
- They've seen an increase of students who might be in a crisis and the sensory room has enabled students to regroup and feel successful. They're continuing to develop the room, but it has already started to help several children. The room helps kids be more successful in their classrooms.
- They're starting to think about how they can start to get to know the kindergarteners before they come to the school a blend in in-person and virtual. They'll get information out about orientation, school tours, and summer assessments soon.
- They need some parent volunteers to help with cafeteria duty (shout out to Stacia Keel for helping!). If you're brave enough to come in and volunteer in the cafeteria, Josh and Susie will train you on how to help. Also looking for volunteers in the library with shelving, etc.
- This week is School Counselor week. Natasha Hill and Cam Boster are doing great at Shrevewood. They're new-ish to this school but are continuing to get to know the community. Celebrate them this week and send them words of encouragement.
