• Kate welcomed the membership to the meeting and the administration and kicked off the meeting.

 - Great week back from Spring Break so far.
 - In the middle of staffing season. They're looking at numbers and staffing changes.
 - 7-10 teachers/staff will be leaving the school next year to pursue other opportunities, be closer to home, etc.
 - Currently fully staffed
 - Lots of potential teachers in the pipeline to come to Shrevewood to fill open slots.
 - SOL season is fast approach. Susie is working on SOL schedule.
 - Communicating schedule in the Wise Words.
 - SOLs start May 3rd
 - Most grades will just have one SOL per week; have a good dinner and breakfast and sleep before the test.
 - Ms. Lilburn will ensure every student has the right accommodations.
 - Results are mailed out and available online.
 - Class Placement Info night is May 19th at 7pm
 - For all grade levels, K 6
 - If you came last month, it will be the same information about providing Level IV curriculum to all students.

- Jeremy Hancock

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• He provided an update on the Safe Routes to School Grant process.

- Program that provides money through VDOT and FCPS to make the school more accessible to walkers and bicycles.
- Process started in earnest 3 years ago. We got a grant for \$500K+ 2 years ago and another \$800K now. Overall project is \$2.1M and is fully funded.
- Crossing from W&OD Trail across the island to Shrevewood; one at Fairwood Lane to the trail with a pedestrian island, and another up Virginia Lane from the W&OD trail to the neighborhood.
- Construction slated for Fall of 2024. Moving in the right direction, but it does take a long time.
- PTA web site will be updated with a picture of the project.
- Another project; huge development effort at West Falls Church metro through Don Beyer Volvo space. PTA has a position on the Committee that's providing advice on how to improve walkability. Survey will come out in early May to allow people to prioritize areas for better walkability.
 - Looking at sidewalk between Shrevewood and Poplar Heights rec club
 - Crossing area at Virginia Lane
 - Jeremy will share the survey so that parents can share opinions.
 - Shreve Rd. is a cut through between these large developments Mosaic and West Falls area.
 - There's a \$6M grant for larger sidewalks from W&OD trail to Rt. 7.
 W&OD trail near Buckelew is going through a study to re-orient in the future.
